Who is eligible for the transportation program?

- All Caledon seniors
- Caledon residents unable to drive because of a short or long-term medical disability or are experiencing mobility issues (clients may be asked to provide a Physician's note)
- Ontario Works clients (essential social services rides arranged by Ontario Works Program)
- People who require dialysis
- TransHelp clients
- York Region and WheelTrans transfer riders

**\*\*PLEASE NOTE\*\***

**If you reside in Caledon and are physically-unable to get in or out of a vehicle due to functional mobility problems such as a wheelchair, you will qualify to use the Region of Peel TransHelp program. Please call TransHelp at 905-791-1015.**

**If you are a senior or someone with a disability that is physically-able to get in and out of a vehicle, please continue with the application for Caledon Community Transportation Services.**
